SPIRITUAL COMMUNION PRAYER

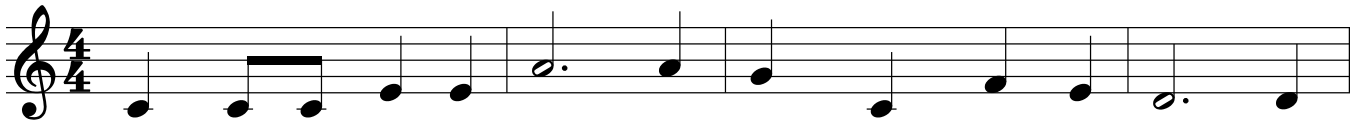
My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.

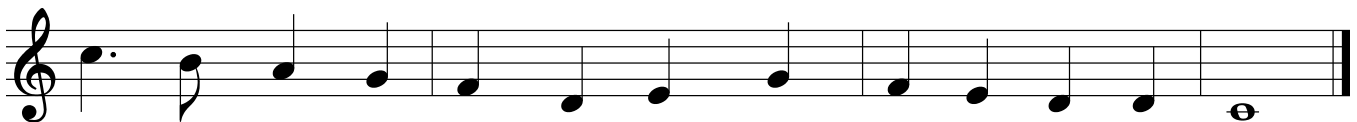
