Building & Renovation Team Update

Currently we are the process of converting our drawing from design presentation drawings into construction drawings for contractors to bid on.

The team will be meeting with the architect on March 13th to confirm things such as room finishes and case-work. If you have any suggestions please contact a team member who will bring your ideas/concerns to this meeting.

Capital Campaign Update

- Pledges and gifts continue to come in from our parishioners and even from outside of our parish,
- Our **goal** is to reach half of the estimated cost in cash on hand -- **\$675,000**.
- As of today we are at \$640,000 so we are only **\$35,000** short of the goal.
- We are entering our third year of the pledge drive for which pledges of \$747,00 were made and there is \$173,000 in pledges yet to be redeemed.

If anyone is not on scheduled payments and able to come up with part of their pledge at this time to help reach or surpass that \$35,000 we need to reach our goal, that would be great.

Thanks be to God and to all who have been so generous towards our building renovation. Keep praying for the success of the project and that our architect and building renovation team will be able to get the plan to contractors for their bids in the next week or so.

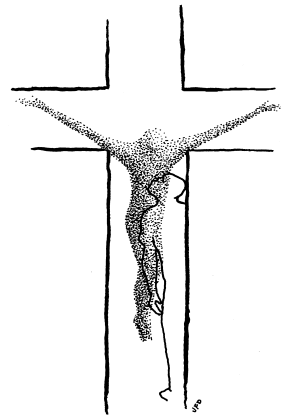

March Food Share Month

This March, we join food shelves, faith communities, businesses, and organizations across Minnesota in acting to end hunger and food insecurity. - Over 3,000,000 visits are made to Minnesota food shelves each year.
 - Approximately 552,000 Minnesotans experience food insecurity.
 - 1 in 7 children in Minnesota struggle with hunger.
 - Local food shelves can stretch your \$ 1 into enough food for 2-3 meals.
 - The 2017 March Campaign raised more than 4.7 million pounds of food and \$8 million for Minnesota food shelves.
 - 100% of financial contributions to Minnesota FoodShare via the March Campaign go to participating food shelves.
- When you pick the food of your land at gathering time, do not pick all the way to the corners of your field. And do not gather the food left on the ground there after you have picked. Do not gather what is left among your vines, or gather the grapes that have fallen. Leave them for those in need and for the stranger. - Leviticus 19:9-10



DOWN ON THE FARM— MDA offering workshops providing support for farm stress

Stress factors are on the rise for Minnesota farmers. Many face financial problems, price and marketing uncertainties, farm transfer issues, production challenges and more. You may know farmers who are struggling with stress, anxiety, depression, burnout, feelings of indecision or suicidal thoughts.

The Minnesota Department of Agriculture is partnering with MFU and a number of other organizations to offer six free, three-hour workshops to help agricultural advisors (and others who work with farmers) recognize and respond when they suspect a farmer or farm family member might need help.
