Capital Campaign Update

We are now at \$650,561 in cash on hand. Since we have paid out approx. \$22,000 to the architect on the final drawings which are part of the total cost of the project, half of that amount (\$11,000) can be added to that figure so that actually we stand at \$661,556 towards the goal of \$675,000 or half the estimated cost of the base project. Therefore we need **\$14,000** yet to reach the goal of **\$675,000** cash on hand.

Building Renovation Team Update

Building plans are progressing. We have a list of contractors that we will be sending our preliminary drawings to by April 16. Complete drawings should be finished by April 26 and will be sent out to them then. We are planning for a pre-bid walk through of our facility on or around May 1st. After the walk through we will be accepting contractor bids through May 10th.

- At the meeting on April 10 the vote was to go with a flat roof over the new construction.
