Sacred Heart Finance Council Notes - June 13

1. Reviewed latest financial reports. Adult envelopes income down slightly from last year, however income still exceeds expenses.
2. Building project expenses came in 12% over estimates for the total project. Building renovation team, capital campaign committee and representatives from the PC and FC will meet with the architect soon to discern how to proceed with the building project. Pat Adrian will represent the finance council.
3. Cemetery committee did meet and adopt rules for the cemetery and arrange for maintenance for this summer.
4. Regional Stewardship Conference in Sioux Falls July 26-27. Julie interested but not able to go this year. Fr. John will send info out to members to consider attending.
5. General cleaning and floor waxing had better participation this year.
6. A new push mower with self-propel option was donated to the parish by Lloyd Foster.
7. Will look into mailing special envelopes to those who use automatic withdrawal.
8. Adam M. raised question of whether we invite people to remember the parish in their wills, etc. We did have a end of life issues and financial planning seminar last summer. However, it did raise the issue of how we educate our parishioners in the area of stewardship. One thing we want to do each year is to have a stewardship presentation as we did last year with Joe Noel. The diocese is working on a list of available speakers. Fr. John will line up a speaker for this fall.
9. Budget work was started by Fr. John and bookkeeper. The committee looked at and approved figures for heating and electricity, salaries, etc. which will Fr. and the bookkeeper finish the budget for approval and for the diocese.
10. Next meeting: Monday, August 6 at 5:15 PM.
