In these unusual times we want to reach out and let you know that we are on this journey together. As we continue through Lent we would like to offer our parish family some resources that may be of spiritual help.

As a reminder, there will be no church activities, including Mass (until further notice). The church is open, however, and you may come in to pray, light candles, and spend time in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Adoration will be in the main body of the church to allow for more people and for more space between people. We encourage you to limit the number of people in the church to ten or less. If you have an assigned Adoration hour and are not comfortable or are not feeling well and cannot come for your regularly scheduled hour, please find a sub or call Cindy Richmond at 256-9958 or Dolores Lucero at 634-6490. Father Tom will continue to hear confessions from 7:30 - 8:00 am on weekdays and from 4:00 - 5:00 pm on Saturdays. Mass intentions will still be honored, as scheduled, in private Masses celebrated by Father Tom.
