QUESTIONS:

Answer the following two questions in 6 to 10 sentences:

1. Why do you desire to be confirmed? What does the word, “confirmed” mean?
2. How does receiving the Holy Spirit in Confirmation help your relationship with Jesus and his Church? What happens to you during Confirmation, both spiritually and physically?

Pick 4 from the following list of questions and answer each in 6 to 10 sentences.

3. Describe the first Confirmation.
4. What does the Church teach about the Mass and Mass attendance? Must we receive communion at every Mass? When should we most especially not receive?
5. Explain the Apostle’s Creed – what are we professing while praying it, what are the 3 main parts of it?
6. What are the 7 Gifts of the Holy Spirit and which one is your strength? Which one do you need to grow in?
7. Name the 7 Sacraments and identify which ones are the Sacraments of Initiation. Explain what each of the Sacraments of Initiation do for us.
8. What are social injustices in the world that we as confirmed Catholics need to be aware of and fight for? Explain the Church’s stance on human life.
9. What do we, as Catholics, believe about the Eucharist?
10. Why is daily prayer important? What are some of the prayers you pray and why?
11. As you are choosing to be a fully initiated Catholic, what does it mean to you to be Catholic?
12. What is your most significant obstacle to being a full and active member of the Church?
