Important Dates:

- **NET Retreat** Thurs, Oct 7 or Fri, Oct 8, 2021
Registration due by **Sept 28**
- **Rite of Acceptance Mass** Sunday, Oct 24 at 6pm with families
Sign in required before Mass, in the Narthex
- **Patron Saint** Research paper on your chosen patron saint.
Follow the guidelines. Due **Nov 10**, turn into your teacher.
- **Confirmation Registration Form** due **Nov 10**, turn into your teacher
- **Choose your sponsor following the Church's guidelines.**
Sponsor fills out *Certificate of Sponsorship* and takes it to his/her parish for signature and seal of the parish.
Due no later than **December 3, 2021**, turn in to your teacher or the SOR office.
- **Palanca Letters *** Due no later than Wed, **Feb 23, 2022** to SOR
Candidates will receive them at their retreat
**Parents –make sure you write a letter!*
- **Confirmation Retreat** Sat, Mar 4 from 10:30am – 6pm includes Mass OR
Sun, Mar 5 from 11:30m -7pm includes Mass
Permission Form due **Feb 23, 2022**.
Attendance required for entire retreat time.
- **Gratitude Grid and Reflection Paper**
completed 30 consecutive days of service
following the guidelines, and signed by parent(s).
Completed no later than **March 2, 2022**
- **Letter to Bishop Dorsonville** Due no later than Tues, **Mar 3, 2022** to SOR
Be sure to sign the letter, follow guidelines

Prior to Confirmation, candidates will undergo an interview for readiness, and go to Confession.

- **Confirmation Rehearsals – Saturday, March 26, 2022**
Sponsor (or Proxy) and candidate must attend.

- **Confirmation Liturgies - Sunday, March 27, 2022**
1:00pm* or 4pm* Mass

*“mystagogy,” from the Greek words meaning “to lead through the mysteries.”
Even though catechetical preparation for full initiation has been completed, there is still much to learn about what it means to live as Catholic Christians. This time after receiving Confirmation is important in helping the newly confirmed process and use the gifts brought by the Holy Spirit for him/her to live a life of faith. The newly confirmed need the ongoing support of the community so that the graces planted in them can grow deep roots.*
