



Holy Trinity School Early Childhood COVID-19 PLAN

As we work to establish the “new normal” circumstances in our school, we must keep mindful that this is the place where our young children develop spiritually, academically, socially, and emotionally so care is always taken to be sure it is a safe and healthy environment to learn, while also facing the reality that we are dealing with young, energetic, spirited, unpredictable children. Every effort is being made to provide the safest but least restrictive environment for our young children. We are also continuously mindful of the mandate given for school which states “recommended practices should be implemented where feasible and practical.” This is the policy we are adapting to at Holy Trinity.

Some major points:

1. All students will need two masks – one they will wear while in the building and one to leave in the building in case of emergency – both masks should be in separate plastic bags that zipper or seal with their name clearly visible.
2. Masks will be worn at all times when the students are moving or changing facilities or common areas. We will be implementing temperature checks every morning until further notice.
3. When children are seated and socially distanced within their own cohort, their masks may be removed. See through desks/sneeze partitions will be used.
4. We strongly suggest buying a lanyard to put on your child’s mask so they can quickly take it on and off but not misplace it.
5. Teachers will wear masks and/or shields.
6. Drop-offs to the cottage in the morning will be between 8:10 am and 8:30 am either by driving down the driveway or entering through the kitchen door.
7. Please be aware that in our “new normal” state and the reasons for social distancing, our classrooms may look a bit different in seating configuration.
8. Cleaning will be done routinely – some things several times a day, some things once a day and some things weekly. All surfaces and materials have been considered for practicality and efficiency. We will be using materials of soap and water, wipes, disinfectant sprays, bleach solution, rug cleaner, and “fogger” spray for cleaning, disinfecting, and sanitizing as recommended by the Center for Disease Control and the Archdiocese of Philadelphia Reopening Plan.

To keep a “fluid operation,” we will be constantly reevaluating and making changes as we make it necessary to keep our children secure.
