POLICY REGARDING DAILY HEALTH MONITORING

This plan calls on every member of the school community to support our values of mutual respect, integrity, willingness to sacrifice for the common good, and fostering community bonds across generations. Commitment to the policies will assist in protecting the health and welfare of all members of our school community.

Pre-Arrival Screening: Each morning before arrival, parents will complete a symptom screening, as stated by the school.

In an effort to keep all children safe, we ask that parents monitor their children's health daily. Below are the expectations related to the health monitoring.

I attest to the fact that my child does not have/exhibit signs of:

- Fever of 100.0 or above
- Chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

I attest:

- My child has not had any contact with anyone with COVID-19.
- My child has not traveled to a location designated as a "Hot Spot."
- I am following all CDC-recommended guidelines and limiting my/my child's exposure to risks, such as those outlined above.

If any of these symptoms are present, please keep your child home and contact the school. If the symptoms are serious, please seek immediate medical attention. Always call before visiting your doctor or health facility.

We will keep you informed if the list of symptoms listed above changes in any way.
