October 23, 2020 (5:00 EST)	Deadline for Internet and telephone registration. No late registration or walk-in process is available this year.
November 1-5, 2020	Obtain your test session date/time/session code available on www.tachsinfo.com. Student will be randomly assigned to 1 of 3 different times on their assigned test date (no time preference accepted). No paper notifications will be sent.
