As we turn the page from Catholic Schools Week and look ahead, the staff at Little Flower is beginning to plan for the 2021-2022 school year. As I think about our opening in mid-August, I will tell you that there is no way to predict whether or not we will still be on Covid-19 class capacity restrictions. Because the possibility of capacity restrictions exists and because we are near that capacity in most classes, we are starting our registration process early this year.

Current LFS families can register students beginning on February 16th. You will receive registration materials in your Thursday packet next week. Please fill out the forms along with the registration fee of \$50 to the school office at your earliest convenience. This form will ensure your spot(s) at Little Flower in the fall. New families who wish to attend our school may register beginning March 1. Our LFS Open House for new families will be held on Tuesday, February 16 from 6-7:30 p.m.



Our current enrollment is over 240 students. With all of the uncertainty in our educational districts across our region, Little Flower continues to be a leader in in-person Catholic education. We appreciate the opportunity to partner with you during this most unusual time.
