Dear LFS Parents:

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we attempt to improve our morning drop-off procedures in order to enhance safety. We have decided to implement one new procedure starting this upcoming Monday. This new procedure applies to preschool parent's drop-off, but will impact all drivers. We will no longer have preschool students enter the preschool outside doors. From Monday on, preschool students will enter using the gym entrance where temperature checks will be conducted. Preschool parents are asked to park in the southeast section of our parking lot and to walk their children to the gym entrance. This step should alleviate traffic congestion in the circle drive.

We have initiated use of orange cones to indicate a prohibited driving area. The intent is to create a safe area for parents to walk students to the gym doors.

As a reminder to all drivers, please do not park on the left side of the circle drive as you let your student out. Also, do not stop in the middle of the circle drive to let students out when there are cars parked to the right. Please find an empty space to pull to the right and allow your child to disembark. If there are no spaces available please wait until one becomes available.
