Some of the kids head for the swings, some to our climbing equipment, others to our new four square court, and some even run pass patterns for an aging principal/quarterback. Recess and P.E. are opportunities for our students to exercise and relax a bit. These activities are an essential aspect of Little Flower's full academic program and mission.

Another aspect of our mission is the partnership that exists between our faculty and you, the parents of our students. In a couple of weeks we will host our Parent-Teacher Conferences.
