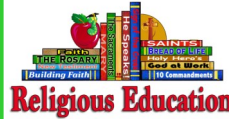

Around the dinner table one night this week, put your phones away and spark a conversation with the following topic:

*List four things that you would say define your family.*

**Did you know that the Catholic Church has Four Marks which distinctly define it as the one true Church? The Catholic Church is one (Jesus established one church with one set of doctrines under one head—the pope), holy (because it is the source of holiness and is the guardian of the special means of grace Jesus established—the sacraments), catholic ( catholic means “universal”, so the Church is for all people in all places for all time), and apostolic (the Catholic Church is the only church which can trace it beginnings back to the twelve apostles.)**
