FROM OUR PASTOR

My Dear Parish Family,

Wednesday, many of us came to Church and were marked with the sign of the cross on our forehead, or ashes were sprinkled on our head, and so began the Season of Lent. During this holy season we as a church gather on Sunday afternoons to pray the Rosary, pray the Stations, eat a simple soup, and watch a movie. This begins at 4:45 pm in the Church.

During Lent it has become our practice to reflect on the Sorrowful Mysteries as we pray the Rosary. As we pray we remember what the Lord did for us as he suffered and died to bring about salvation. During this season of the Rosary we begin by asking those present to pray for and end to abortion, and pray that all people have the dignity of a good life. Life is precious.

Following the Rosary we move into the Stations of the Cross. We pray as we process around the Church remembering and walking the road to Calvary with Jesus. Once again, like with the Rosary, we focus on the passion and death of Jesus and reflect on the fact that he suffered and died for you and for me, for our salvation. During the moments we genuflect before each station we pray: "We adore you, O Christ, and we praise you. Because by your Holy Cross you have redeemed the world." Then the name of the station is proclaimed, and we end with a short prayer. It is a beautiful way to reflect on the walk of Jesus as he willingly gave up his life for us.

After Stations of the Cross, we move into Annunciation Hall for a simple soup supper. Normally, we have two kinds of soup, bread and maybe a little treat to end the meal. This is a time to visit with fellow parishioners and enjoy some pretty good soup. Each week different people make the soup and feed the group. Masks will be worn and social distancing will be observed.

After the Simple Soup Supper we go into the parish Library and watch a DVD Series called the "Chosen", a series that has been seen on TV.

I invite everyone to come and pray with our Parish Family on Sundays. I ask you to wear your mask and keep the distance -6 feet. Come to a part of the evening of to the whole evening.

One update on my health... I began training for the at home dialysis – Peritoneal Dialysis. My regular dialysis will remain on M-W-F from 6:30 am until 10:30 am and then I will attend a training classes until 3 pm. This will be my schedule until the beginning of March at which time I am hoping to be able to do the dialysis at home and be able to celebrate Mass each morning with you.

Happy Lent. Remember to Pray—Fast—Give Alms.
