About this Resources:

This is a simple response page for students to use after they have learned about Baptism in the classroom. To complete the activity, students list five people or objects that are at a Baptism (water, white gown, candle, priest, parents, God, godparents, fountain, etc.) Students will also draw a picture of Baptism and fill in blank spaces to complete the sentence the priest says during Baptism ("I baptize you in the name of the ____, and of the ____, and of the ____.")

Classroom Instructional Ideas:

- As you begin to study about Baptism, invite students to bring photos or mementos from their own baptisms. Gowns, candles, and photos are all great objects to share in the classroom.
- Discuss symbols and people in a modern day Baptism... look for these elements in student photos .
- Read a Bible passage about Jesus' own Baptism (Mark 1:11-9, Luke 3:21-22, Matthew 3:13-17).
- Let students role play Baptism in the classroom. Use a baby doll, a small cup, and a bowl of water. Allow the children to take turns acting as the priest, mom, dad, and godparents. Let the child acting as the priest wear a scarf and pretend it is a stole.

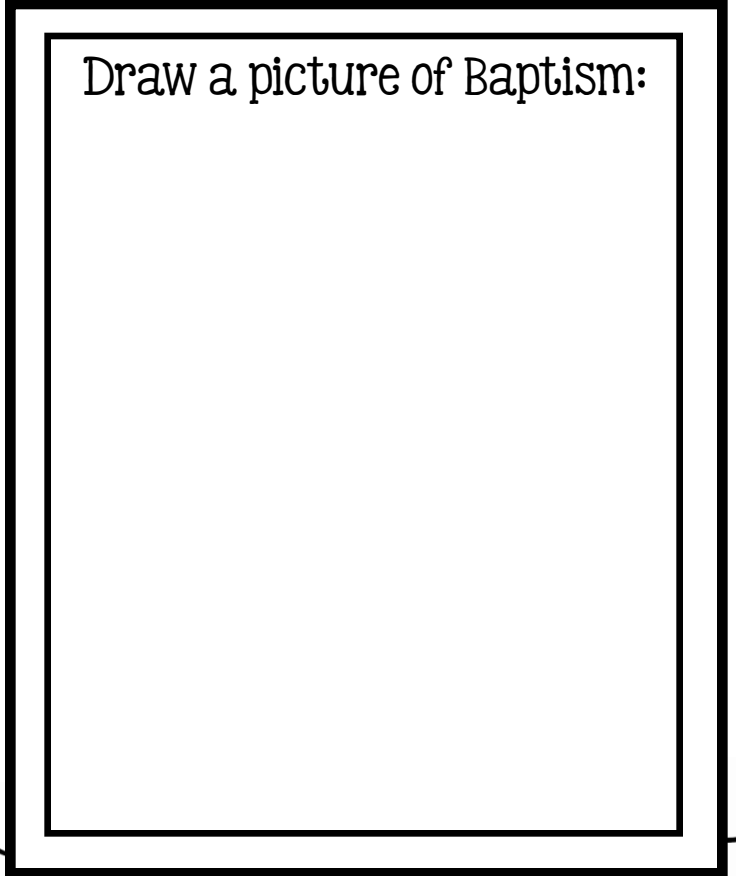
