- D. This is the day that Jesus suffered and died on the cross.
- E. Judas Iscariot betrayed Jesus on this day by taking 30 pieces of silver from the high priests.
- F. The week preceding Easter and the final week of Lent that begins with Palm Sunday and ends on Holy Saturday.
- G. Jesus rose from the dead on this day.
- H. This is the day that Jesus celebrated the Last Supper with the apostles, as well as washing their feet, prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane, and was arrested and taken before Pontius Pilate.
