CORPUS CHRISTI

An American priest, Fr. Frank Ramsberger, was touring the Holy Land. He especially wanted to study the places where Jesus lived, worked, suffered, died and rose from the dead. He became good friends with a young boy named Josef. The boy served the Mass and taught the priest some of the difficult Arabic words. As the priest was about to leave for other parts of the Holy Land, he told Josef: “Not many boys and girls have the privilege of living in the land where Jesus lived. You know that God’s son, as a boy and as a man, walked these roads and breathed this air. Doesn’t that help you to love Him more?” Josef gave this thoughtful answer: “You don’t have to live here to love our Lord, because now He lives in every part of the world. Every land now is the Holy Land. Wherever we are, we are in the land of Jesus.”

Did you ever think of this: Paterson is part of the Holy Land? Jesus lives right here, right now. This is our thought on this feast of Corpus Christi, when we recall that Holy Thursday, when He first spoke the words: “This is my Body. This is my Blood.” Today we celebrate the fact that these words are repeated all over the world every day, that Jesus is present on altars all over the world. Christ lives here.

Today is Father’s Day too. In the Holy Land Jesus honored His heavenly Father. In our limited way we honor our fathers. Tell your father, as Jesus often told His father, that you love him, you appreciate what he has done for you. Happy Father’s Day. God bless you! – **Fr. Leo**

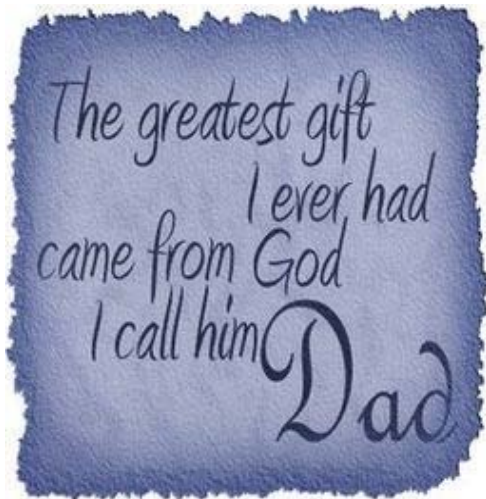

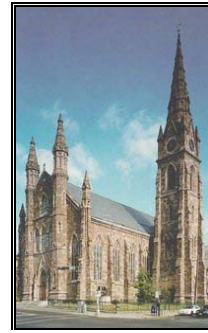

SAFE PROGRAM

FOR CHILDREN & YOUTH

1. *Screening of staff/volunteers*
2. *Adults trained in safe environment strategies and signs of abuse.*
3. *Code of conduct enforced*
4. *Open communication between parents and staff/staff and children/children and parents.*
5. *Parents are always welcome*
6. *Children are educated about right relationships & what to do if a relationship is not right.*
7. *All children are treated with dignity and respect.*
8. *Clear rules and expectations. Consistent reinforcement/consequences.*
9. *Adequate supervision of youth. Team approach/accountability/no 1:1 isolation.*
10. *All abuse is reported.*
