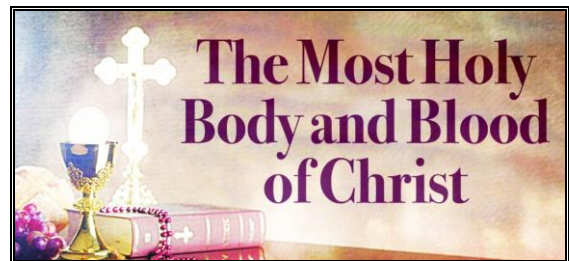

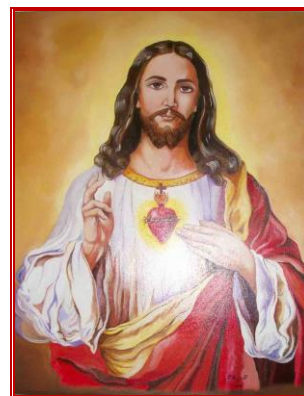

The Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary

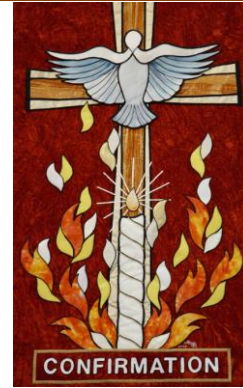


FEAST DAY: JUNE 12TH
