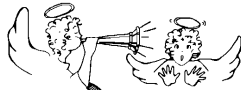
Vocations Prayer Ministry

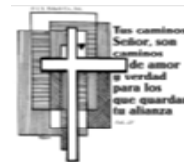

Hoy se celebra la festividad de la Cátedra de San Pedro, una ocasión solemne que se remonta al siglo cuarto, con la que se rinde homenaje, se celebra el primado y la autoridad de San Pedro.

Antes de rezar el Ángelus en este día, el Papa Juan Pablo II recordó, que, "la festividad litúrgica de la Cátedra de San Pedro subraya el singular ministerio que el Señor confió al jefe de los Apóstoles, de confirmar y guiar a la Iglesia en la unidad de la fe."

"En esto consiste el 'Ministerium Petrinum', ese servicio peculiar que el Obispo de Roma está llamado a rendir a todo el pueblo cristiano. Misión indispensable, que no se basa en prerrogativas humanas, sino en Cristo mismo como piedra angular de la comunidad eclesial."

"Recemos", -dijo-, "para que la Iglesia, en la variedad de culturas, lenguas y tradiciones, sea unánime en creer y profesar las verdades de fe y de moral transmitidas por los Apóstoles."

Todos los años en esta fecha, el altar monumental que acoge la Cátedra de San Pedro, permanece iluminado todo el día con docenas de velas. Se celebran numerosas misas desde la mañana hasta el atardecer, concluyendo con la Eucaristía del Capítulo de San Pedro.
