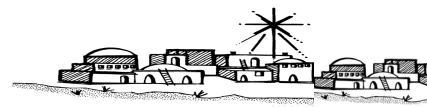

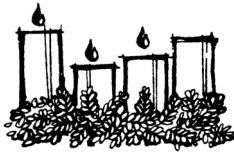


¿Qué son las Posadas?
