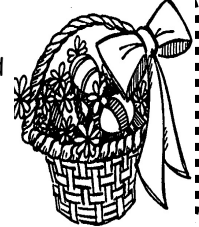

**Lenten Regulations**

- + **Good Friday** is a day of **fast** (see below) and **abstinence** (eating no meat).
- + Everyone **over 14 years of age** is bound to **abstain from meat on all Fridays** of Lent.
- + Everyone over 18 and under 59 years of age is bound to **fast** on Good Friday. On a day of fast, only one full meal is allowed; two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. If in doubt concerning fast or abstinence, a priest should be consulted.
- + During Lent, Catholics are encouraged to **pray more** often. It is the ideal time to receive the sacrament of penance (confession).
- + **Almsgiving**, gifts to charity and to the poor are encouraged as a way of sharing God's gifts to us.

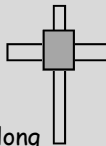

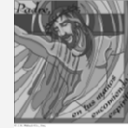
Siguiendo la petición del Papa Francisco a “vivir la justicia social”, en donde nos encontremos ya eso nos significa como personas e hijos de Dios.

## ¡BENDITO EL QUE VIENE EN NOMBRE DEL SEÑOR!

(LUCAS 19:28-40)

El Domingo de Ramos del 2019 se celebra el 14 de Abril, es una fecha que cambia todos los años. Marca además el comienzo de la Semana Santa, un período donde se conmemoran la Pasión, Muerte y Resurrección de Jesús. En este día se recuerda a Jesucristo cuando realizó la entrada triunfal a Jerusalén. Fue alabado por una multitud que lo aclamaba como Rey con cantos y palmas.

Las ceremonias litúrgicas del Domingo de Ramos comienzan con la bendición de las palmas y ramas de olivo que llevan los fieles a la Parroquia, rememorando este pasaje del evangelio. Los días que van hasta el Jueves Santo pertenecen al “tiempo cuaresmal” y están caracterizados por los últimos acontecimientos de la vida del Señor. Los ramos simbolizan la participación gozosa en el rito procesional, en el que Cristo va hacia la muerte para la salvación de todos los hombres. Así este Domingo tiene un doble carácter, de gloria y de sufrimiento.

También es tradicional que los ramos bendecidos en las iglesias se lleven a las casas, para colocarlos sobre un crucifijo o cualquier elemento sagrado de la vivienda. Siendo así un símbolo de la bendición de Dios y protección para toda la familia.

### Significado

Pero el Domingo de Ramos es algo más, significa también el camino que nos lleva al encuentro de Jesús para que nos acompañe siempre y pueda instaurar su paz en el mundo. Jesús nos mostró su humildad entrando a Jerusalén en un burrito, enseñándonos también que no debemos ser soberbios ni vanidosos.

Este día es un recordatorio de como a veces aclamamos a Jesús, como lo hicieron los judíos, y como en otras ocasiones lo condenamos con nuestros pecados. Hemos de reflexionar sobre nuestros actos de aquí en adelante, para ser coherentes entre la fe cristiana y la vida cotidiana.

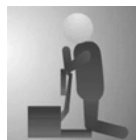

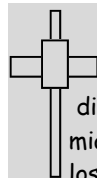
