Receiving Communion in the Hand

Do not walk away with the sacred host. Consume it immediately after the priest or Eucharistic minister places it on your hand. Remember that it is actually the Body of Christ, and should be treated with great reverence! Never take the Eucharist out of the church. *Recently we found consecrated hosts on the floor near the back of church. If you see someone discarding a host, please call it to the attention of the sacristan or priest, and if you see it happen, say something to that person! Maybe they don't know any better.*



HOLY MASS includes the Final Blessing by the priest. Unless you have an urgent reason for leaving before this, you should fulfill the obligation to participate at the entire Sunday Mass, stay for the Final Blessing.
