





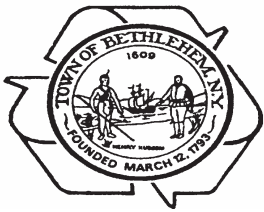
VOLUNTARY RECYCLING LIST

- **Antifreeze:** Bring to local radiator shops. Never leave at an unattended service station.
- **Batteries – Household NOTE: Throw all alkaline batteries into the regular trash.** Collection boxes are located throughout Town for Lithium, Ni-Cad (rechargeable), button, nickel hydride, manganese, computer, and cell phone batteries.
- **Batteries – Vehicle:** Trade in for a new battery, or bring to a scrap metal dealer in the Port of Albany.
- **CD's, DVD's and Computer Games:** Bring to Highway Garage for recycling.
- **Cell Phones:** Recycle at Town Hall and Highway Garage during normal hours.
- **Compact Fluorescent Bulbs (CSL's):** Town Hall & Highway Garage during normal hours.
- **Computer, TVs, Electronics:** Rupert Road Transfer Station on-going, or Fall Collection (9/23 and 9/24/11) at Highway Garage.
- **WNYT Electronics Collection:** Computers, TVs, etc. Taft Furniture, Albany. Sat. April 23, 2011, 7AM –1PM.
- **Fluorescent Bulbs:** Highway Garage during normal hours or Household Hazardous Waste Day on 5/7/11 (the bulbs contain mercury).
- **Milk and Juice Cartons:** Commingle with bottles and cans in recycling bin, please drain and rinse.
- **Motor Oil:** Bring to service station or large retailer of motor oil. Maximum is 5 gallons per person, per day. Never leave at an unattended service station.
- **Plastic Store Bags:** Recycle at Wal-mart, Hannaford, CVS or other large retail stores.
- **Styrofoam Packing “Peanuts” and Blocks:** Give to packaging companies, such as Ship, Copy, and More; UPS and FedEx. Foam blocks can be saved up and taken to Shelter Enterprises in Cohoes. Call the Town Recycling Coordinator for details.
- **Propane Tanks (20 lbs.):** Rupert Road Transfer Station, \$3.00 each.
- **Six Pack Beverage Rings (Hi-Cones):** Recycle in special boxes at Town Hall, Town Park, and Highway Garage.

NEWSPAPER <i>Including Inserts</i>	Recycle per hauler's instructions or at Transfer Station. DO NOT leave out in the rain or snow. CORRUGATED CARDBOARD & Paperboard <i>triple and single layer</i>	FLATTEN To save your space and ours. Empty all contents. Boxes will collapse when the bottom is opened.	
PAPER BAGS <i>All Non-Shiny Paper Bags OK</i>	Empty, flatten and place with corrugated cardboard.	
MAGAZINES AND CATALOGS	Recycle per hauler's instructions or at Transfer Station. Call your hauler if unsure of instructions.	
HOME, OFFICE, SCHOOL PAPER <i>and Junk mail</i>	Recycle per hauler's instructions or at Transfer Station. Include stationery, photocopies, store receipts, envelopes, junk mail.	
CONTAINERS	HOW TO PREPARE	
GLASS BOTTLES & JARS <i>Clear, Green, Brown</i>	Remove caps, lids, rings. Rinse thoroughly and drain. Labels are okay. Do not crush. Recycle per hauler's instructions or at Transfer Station.	Plastic spray nozzles Window or auto glass Ceramics or crystal Mirrors; Drinking glasses Pyrex dishes/pans Styrofoam food containers Plexiglas Motor oil containers Alkaline Batteries <p style="text-align: center;">***</p> Recycle plastic bags/film at retail stores Donate small appliances (recycle computers, phones, electronics at Town Collection Events or Transfer Station) Alkaline batteries (recycle non-alkaline batteries throughout Town*) Recycle metal objects at the Rupert Road Transfer Station
PLASTIC CONTAINERS <i>All plastic containers and lids EXCEPT NO Styrofoam, NO plastic bags/film, and NO "compostable" or "bio-degradable" plastics. See Town website for info.</i>	Remove and discard spray nozzles and non-plastic tops. Rinse or wash thoroughly, drain Flatten large milk, juice jugs. Squeeze air out of bottles. (Return deposit bottles to stores)	
METAL CANS <i>Aluminum Tin, Bi-metal</i>	Rinse or wash thoroughly. Include all metal lids in the can. (Do NOT need to remove labels) Empty Aerosol cans are OK.	
ALUMINUM TRAYS AND ALUMINUM FOIL	Rinse or clean thoroughly for reuse or recycling.	

*Battery recycling at Town Hall, Town Highway Garage, Post Offices in Slingerlands and Selkirk, and Radio Shack in Glenmont.
