In order to avail for the Full Plenary Indulgence, the following requirements need to be met:

- a. make a pilgrimage visit to the church of St. Joseph, Inalahan.
- b. go to Confession
- c. attend mass and receive Communion
- d. pray for the intentions of the Holy Father

Furthermore, the elderly, the sick and those who cannot leave their home may also obtain the Full Plenary Indulgence. They must show sorrow for their sins and observe the three usual conditions, even as they spiritually unite themselves with the Jubilee celebrations and offer to God their own trials and sufferings.

4) In order to encourage our parishioners to avail the Full Plenary Indulgence, Confession will be made available 30 minutes before Mass or by appointment.
