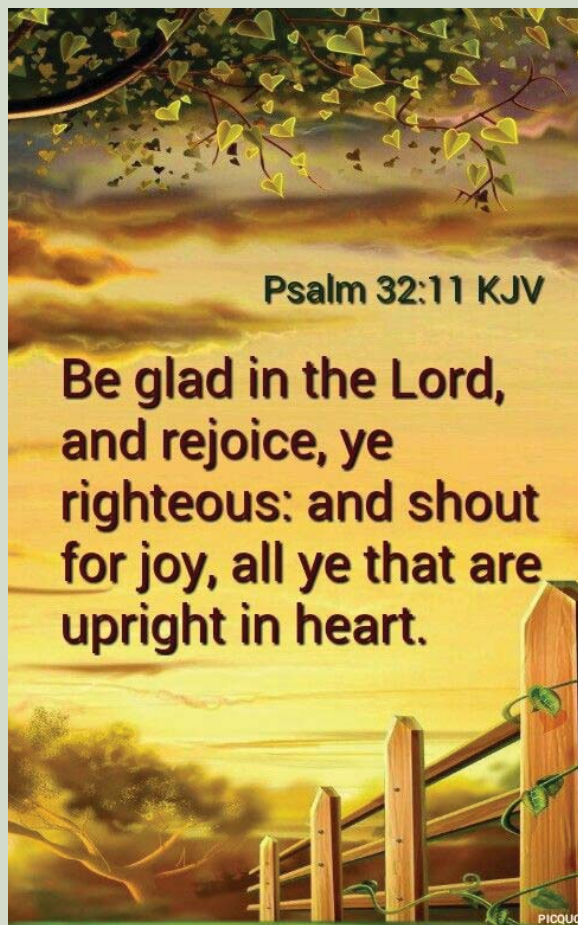

- * Pope Francis, in his usual inspiring insightful and utterly practical way, insists that every person is called by God to follow his or her own unique path to holiness according to the gifts that God has given. Calling the Beatitudes the Christian's "Identity Card," he says they can help us discern the Holy Spirit's movement and guidance in the depths of our heart. He makes us aware of the serious obstacles to holiness and how we need to address these. While holiness requires silence, solitude and constant prayer, it also sends us out in loving compassion and mercy to minister to poverty and injustice in our world.
- * The Day of Prayer begins at 9:00am and ends at 3:30pm. Mass will be celebrated during this time.
- * The offering is \$35, which includes lunch.
- * The Day of Prayer is open to men and women.
