MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: FEDERAL TAX EXEMPT STATUS OF THE DIOCESE OF TRENTON
and its affiliated Churches, Schools, Agencies and Instrumentalities.

The Diocese of Trenton is incorporated as a religious corporation in the State of New Jersey for educational, charitable and religious purposes. The Diocese is an instrumentality of the Roman Catholic Church in the United States and is exempt from Federal income tax under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986(Code).

Churches, educational institutions, agencies and instrumentalities of the Roman Catholic Church in the United States and the Diocese of Trenton, described in sections 501(c)(3) and 170(G)(1)(A) of the Code, are exempt from federal income tax without filing an exemption application. However, the United States Catholic Conference represents the Catholic Church and annually receives an Internal Revenue Services (IRS) group ruling letter indicating all agencies of the Catholic Church, listed in the Official Catholic Directory, are exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

The group ruling further exempts these institutions from federal unemployment tax under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act (FUTA). The group ruling also establishes that contributions to the Diocese of Trenton, its churches, schools, agencies and instrumentalities are deductible for federal income, gift and estate tax purposes as provided by Section 107 of the Code. In addition, the Diocese and its related organizations are not required to file an IRS Form 990.

Our Lady of Sorrows School, Hamilton, NJ 08619 listed on page 1435 of The Official Catholic Directory for 2010, is covered by the above provisions.

Dear Sir/Madam:

This responds to your July 9, 2010, request for information regarding the status of your group tax exemption.

Our records indicate that you were issued a determination letter in March 1946, that you are currently exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and are not a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Code because you are described in sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(i).

With your request, you provided a copy of the *Official Catholic Directory for 2010*, which includes the names and addresses of the agencies and instrumentalities and the educational, charitable, and religious institutions operated by the Roman Catholic Church in the United States, its territories, and possessions that are subordinate organizations under your group tax exemption. Your request indicated that each subordinate organization is a non-profit organization, that no part of the net earnings thereof inures to the benefit of any individual, and that no substantial part of their activities is for promotion of legislation. You have further represented that none of your subordinate organizations is a private foundation under section 509(a), although all subordinates do not all share the same sub-classification under section 509(a). Based on your representations, the subordinate organizations in the *Official Catholic Directory for 2010* are recognized as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Code under GEN 0928.

Donors may deduct contributions to you and your subordinate organizations as provided in section 170 of the Code. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to them or for their use are deductible for federal estate and gifts tax purposes if they meet the applicable provisions of section 2055, 2106, and 2522 of the Code.


Subordinate organizations under a group exemption do not receive individual exemption letters. Most subordinate organizations are not separately listed in Publication 78 or the EO Business Master File. Donors may verify that a subordinate organization is included

in your group exemption by consulting the *Official Catholic Directory*, the official subordinate listing approved by you, or by contacting you directly. IRS does not verify the inclusion of subordinate organizations under your group exemption. See IRS Publication 4573, *Group Exemption*, for additional information about group exemptions.

Each subordinate organization covered in a group exemption should have its own EIN. Each subordinate organization must use its own EIN, not the EIN of the central organization, in all filings with IRS.
