The Sacrament of Reconciliation: The sacrament is available in Strasburg from 3:15-3:50 p.m. on Saturdays, in Hague from 6:15-6:50 p.m. on Saturdays, and at St. Michael Church 10:30-10:55 a.m. on Sundays. The sacrament is also available about 15 minutes prior to each weekday Mass and can be scheduled at your convenience by calling the parish office.

Eucharistic Adoration at Sts. Peter & Paul Parish of Strasburg on Tuesdays at 3 p.m. followed by Mass. No Adoration at St. Mary's Parish during Lent.

Lenten Regulations

* **Abstinence:** Catholics 14 and older must not eat meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and on all the Fridays of Lent.

* **Fasting:** Catholics aged 18 to 59 years are required to fast on

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these days, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals may be taken if needed, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.

* **Sacrament of Penance:** Catholics older than about 2nd grade are obliged to confess their sins at least once a year. Lent fitting time to fulfill this requirement.

* **Other Lenten Observances:** Each weekday of Lent is also a day of penance. Some recommendations include attending daily Mass, increased prayer and a good time to checkout FORMED, self-imposed fasting or abstinence, works of charity, giving to the poor, and participation in traditional Lenten devotions such as the Stations of the Cross, the Rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, etc.

Rice Bowls are in the back of all the Churches. Through the Rice Bowl we deepen our experiences of Lent by devoting prayers, fasting and gifts to transform the lives of the poor. Pickup a Rice Bowl before leaving Mass this Wednesday.

The Strasburg KCs would like to invite you again this Lenten Season to join them in supporting our local food pantry with **"40 Cans for Lent"**. Why not commit, as a family, to donate one can or non-perishable food item per day in Lent? Our goal is to collect 1000 lbs. If this goal is met, the Supreme Council will give the Strasburg KCs \$100.00 which the KCs would also donate to the food pantry. Boxes are in place in the middle entry way of the Sts. Peter and Paul Church in Strasburg. Boxes will also be placed in Hague, Westfield, & Linton.

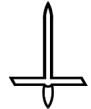
