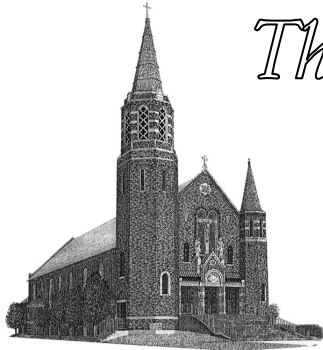
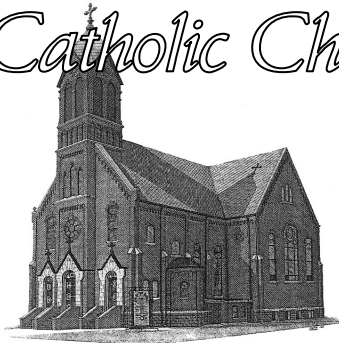


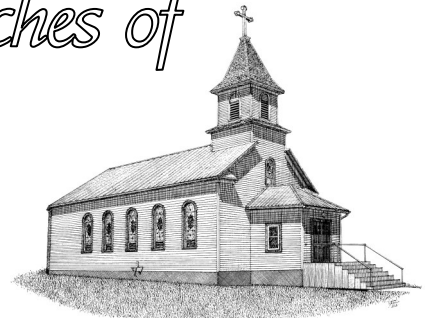

**Intercessions For Life:** For those who are imprisoned, especially those condemned to death: May they be treated with the respect due to every human person.....We pray to the Lord:

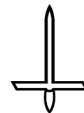
