FROM FATHER MIKE

Liam has roots in Westfield down near Indianapolis, and he has a background in ministry as he worked on the staff at St. Alphonsus Catholic Church in Zionsville, also down near Indianapolis. One of the goals of a summer assignment is for our seminarians to experience life in our parishes, and Liam has been specifically assigned to this area to get a sense of the more rural part of the diocese.
