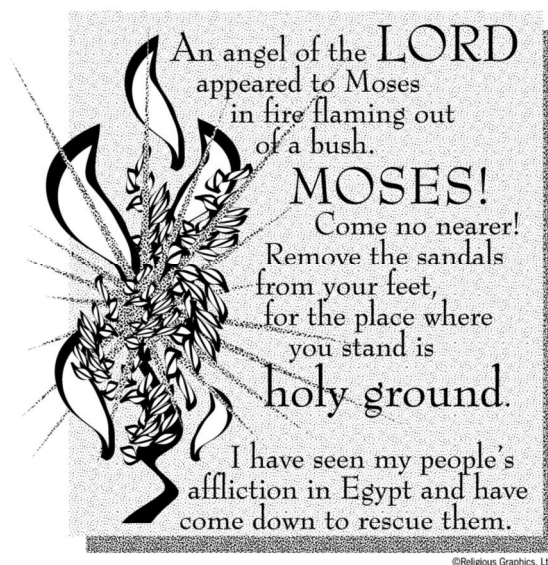

### ***From Father Mike***

This weekend you will notice that we are being asked to make an annual contribution to Catholic Relief Service (CRS). Last week there was a bulletin insert that gave you more information on this organization, and I'm leaving extra copies of this insert in the back of church if you didn't see it. I wanted to share with you some additional information about this charitable outreach of the U.S. Catholic Church in order to ensure everyone understands how it fits into the bigger picture of how our church helps the poor. CRS uses the contributions from all the parishes within the United States for efforts to help the needy in other parts of the world. Each fall there is another collection for the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) that organizes the American Catholic Church's charitable efforts here within this country. Consistently rated among the best organizations for helping the poor because it spends a minimal amount of money on administrative costs (usually under 10%), CRS has longstanding connections to work in all parts of the globe and technical expertise to respond quickly to emergencies. It also has the vision to how best help people to be lifted out of poverty and thus experience their basic human dignity instead of just handing out aid. I am aware that people are having mixed feelings about the Catholic Church these days and are tired of all the scandals, but the work of groups like CRS remind us that we never stop living out our faith and will strive constantly to care for our brothers and sisters in need throughout the world.

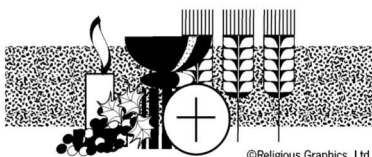
