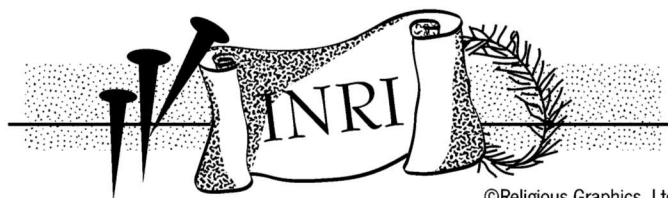

From Father Mike

One of the things that makes Palm Sunday a favorite for Catholics is that they get to go home with something extra. Yes, it is only a freshly cut piece of a plant from a warmer climate that will soon turn dry and brown, but we still love to get a palm. Then we go home and display it the rest of the year somewhere in the house, perhaps hanging near a religious picture or crucifix. At work is our need to reinforce our Catholic identity with that constant reminder of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. The reading of Christ's passion each Palm Sunday shows that the triumph of Jesus was not that of a person who rises to political power or is otherwise popular with the people but a complete conquering of evil by a man who is tortured and crucified by shady religious leaders in concert with Roman government officials. Yet the palms not only trigger memories of Jerusalem as the place of agony, betrayal, and murder but the place in which the resurrection was initiated. So the triumph of our Lord may have been different than what people thought when he first came to Jerusalem, but happily for us it was something much better. When you look at your palm on one of the walls of your home this coming year, may it stir your desire to welcome Jesus into your life and your family, especially his comprehensive victory over every form of sin and evil.
