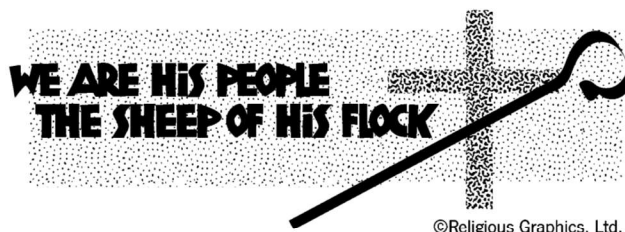

From Father Mike

I love this Fourth Sunday of Easter because the readings always have something to do with shepherds, sheep, and flocks. Part of my enthusiasm comes from my enjoyment of being a shepherd, especially as I feel I have been around enough to get to know many of you and what you need to grow in your faith. The image of shepherd describes my own sense of call to help protect, care for, and nurture the souls of this parish and those in our local community. I appreciate the privilege and challenge of learning where are each individual sheep and the flock of the parish as a whole as fellow disciples, and how we can help further develop our relationship with Jesus and share him with others. One of the ongoing struggles I believe we all have is how we best understand ourselves as part of a flock, both as a parish and a diocese. As Americans, we are immersed in a culture of individualism and also currently live in an era of tribalism, where we can identify with one group of people of common ideology who oppose those of other philosophical preferences. To be Catholic is to have a “flock mentality” of being part of a larger collective of persons where we focus as much on our unity in Christ and what we can do together than what makes us philosophically distinctive from others. Watch for more on this as we will soon be having conversations about how we will be operating as a church that are directed by the diocese as part of a strategic pastoral planning process.
