From Father Mike

The celebration of Pentecost is rooted in the Jewish festival of Shavout. As the Passover marked Israel's freedom from slavery to Pharaoh, the occurrence of Shavout a few weeks later marked Israel's reception of the law that God gave to Moses on Mount Sinai, becoming a nation committed to serving God. For Christians, the corresponding festivals are Easter, when we freed from the slavery of sin and death, and today's feast of Pentecost, our reception of the Holy Spirit to live as a people committed to serving Christ. The Jews would annually renew their covenant relationship of belonging to God as first given to Moses on Mount Sinai during Shavout, which lent itself to also being a good time to receive new members into the community. The Shavout was based on the time when wheat would be harvested, thus representing a time that God was harvesting new persons into his chosen people. The main effect of the Pentecost event in Acts 2 was not just the tongues of fire descending on the apostles but what happened next. Peter preached the core of the gospel, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the holy Spirit," which resulted in "those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand persons were added that day." (Acts 2:38, 41). May the Holy Spirit continue to use us to ever increase those who are harvested by God into the covenant community of the church.
