From Father Mike

If you have been paying attention to this bulletin and to our diocesan paper *The Catholic Moment*, you have noticed several mentions of the *Uniting in Heart 2030 Pastoral Plan*. You can get more information and updates at www.dol-in.org/uniting-in-heart. In today's world, we are used to hearing organizations talk about making strategic plans and see how they make shifts with the focus of their mission or in the way they operate. This diocesan plan will be showing us a new way of doing church based on the need for us to emphasize our purpose of becoming better disciples of Jesus and sharing his gospel of salvation to others. Everyone is invited to attend a live presentation and offer feedback at All Saints Church in Logansport on Wednesday, June 26, 2:00pm. Soon thereafter the plan with opportunities to give feedback will be available to everyone online. What is making this plan different is that it is a comprehensive design affecting all ministries across the diocese. This is because it is not just strategic but pastoral. What is the difference? Strategic planning is determining what we feel we should be doing, and pastoral planning is looking at what God is calling us to do. The second reading invokes some of the Trinitarian formula of prayer appropriate on this feast of the Holy Trinity when Paul writes to the Romans that "...hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us." God is giving our church an opportunity to change in order that we might better share the love that God gives us. While change can be scary, it will be a great blessing when prompted by the Holy Spirit, so we anticipate the upcoming *Uniting in Heart 2030 Pastoral Plan* with a tremendous sense of hope.

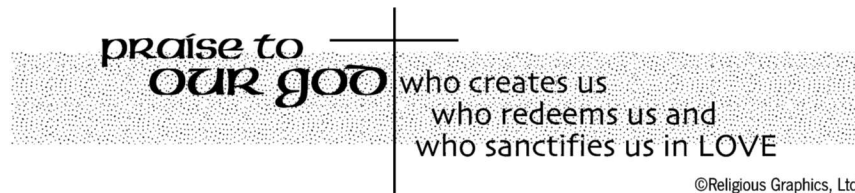
