### ***From Father Mike***

I hope you have had a chance to look at the draft of the Uniting in Heart 203 Pastoral Plan. It was included in the last edition of The Catholic Moment or online at [www.dol-in.org/uniting-in-heart](http://www.dol-in.org/uniting-in-heart). I also hope you have given your feedback, whether it be your comments or questions. Bishop Doherty has offer various means to allow everyone a chance to share their ideas. If you are having trouble getting a copy or leaving your comments, let me know as you still have until this Friday, July 19. Meanwhile, as it is easy to get focused on the changes in the plan and the different ways we will be structured as a diocese, I wish to continue to call us back to the vision of Uniting in Heart. In particular, it calls us to see ourselves as "...a unified community of faithful that is experienced as welcoming, caring, and engaged evangelists accompanying people on their faith journey towards Jesus Christ and His Church." As you may be aware, I write this column for all three parishes under my care, but something I noticed last weekend was that at all the Masses at all the parishes there were people present who are not normally at Mass. I also noticed that no one seemed to know who they were, which means that no one introduced themselves or asked them their name or where they are from. If we are going to be a welcoming and caring people, it has to start with all of us taking the responsibility of going out of our way to make sure everyone experiences our joy that they have come to celebrate the Eucharist. As the Good Samaritan extended gracious care to a stranger, so too we can embrace this vision of welcoming and caring to others first and foremost when we gather for Mass each Lord's Day.
