I take this opportunity to thank all of you for all that you do for our Parish. You all have seen the Blessed Mother Statue outside our Church. Whenever I look at that statue I used think of converting that place as a place of prayer in other words a **Prayer Garden**. To make it a place of Prayer we need to make few benches around the statue.
