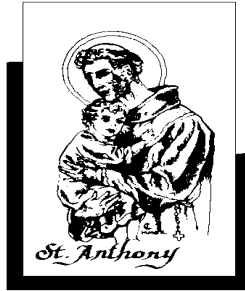

ANNUAL FRENCH MASS ON THE SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION

Please join us for the annual French Mass on the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary which will be celebrated as a Vigil Mass on Friday, August 14, 2020 at 6:00 PM at St. Hilary Church in Mathews. The Most Reverend Shelton Fabre will preside and deliver the homily, and recently ordained Rev. Daniel Duplantis, Associate Pastor at St. Thomas Aquinas Church, Thibodaux, will be the principal celebrant at this Mass on the occasion of the patron feast of Catholics of French heritage. The hygienic guidelines related to the pandemic which are currently in place (including wearing face masks) for Sunday Masses in the Diocese of Houma-Thibodaux will be observed. There will be no supper following the Mass.
