



St. Mary's School lunchroom news

Welcome new and returning families!

In your family folder, you should have received a packet with the guidelines for our online lunch ordering program. The program we utilize is called My School Account. This MSA packet will help you to setup and register your student with www.myschoolaccount.com. This website allows you to deposit monies from a checking account or credit card into an account that will be used for ala carte and preordering lunches each month.

There are a couple of changes to this year's lunch program. First, we will be changing from weekly orders to a monthly ordering system. You will be given one week in each month to go online and order for the *entire* upcoming month. Please try to have your orders in within the given deadline. We will not be able to accept orders past the cutoff date. Also, when placing your lunch orders please make sure to complete your order by clicking "FINISH" at the end of the process.

Second, students will have the option to select bottled water with their lunch in place of milk. Milk and water can also be purchased separately for \$.50 daily.

In the event that your child has forgotten their lunch, we will always provide him/her with a lunch. This lunch may consist of the hot lunch on menu (only if quantities are available) or a pb&j sandwich, milk, and a side option for \$3.50, which will be charged to their account. This lunch includes milk or water.

In case of illness or field trips the students accounts will be credited. The only exception to this will be sub sandwiches ordered on Jimmy John's days. These cannot be credited.

A la carte items will be offered to students in grades 5-8 only. Items range from \$.50-\$2.00 each. The items offered include ice cream cups, cookies, ice cream sandwiches, Gatorade, fruit snacks, and chips. These items will be charged to their account and you have the option to login and see what they have been purchasing.
