I would also like to use that forum to develop small faith communities in the parish in order to build a stronger parish. To me, the strength of a parish depends on the bonds that holds it together, the bonds formed among the parishioners that unite us together.

That is my focus which I know won’t appeal to everyone, but there are also many other forms of learning and great material available that could enrich the faith life of us all.

So, I am seeking members of a search committee to work with me in drawing up a job description, advertise and seek people interested in such a position and be involved in the selection of a person that would serve the parish in developing opportunities for adult faith formation.
