Believe it or not, this coming Saturday is the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. The secular observance of the 4<sup>th</sup> of July must in no way diminish the primary focus of this week-end's celebration as the celebration of the Paschal Mystery.

**Moderator** – Can. 517 §1. When circumstances require it, the pastoral care of a parish or of different parishes together can be entrusted to several priests in solidum, with the requirement, however, that in exercising pastoral care one of them must be the moderator, namely, the one who is to direct the joint action and to answer for it to the bishop.

**Associate Pastor** – A priest of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana who by virtue of the grace of God has demonstrated particular gifts and charisms that contribute to the vitality of the parishes and schools of the diocese. As a man that is passionate, humble and smart he is placed in an assignment where his gifts are best suited to the needs of a pastorate or diocesan office and will contribute to the fulfillment of the ministry and mission of the diocese. The associate is appointed by the bishop for full time ministry to be part of the clergy team of a parish. In this capacity, associate priests report to the Pastor and are co-



workers with the pastor and sharers in pastoral care of the parish according to his gifts. A man with many years of pastoral ministry may be named a Senior Associate Pastor. This does not indicate a reduced or part time role in the pastorate or diocesan office.

\*NOTE: the term co-pastor will not be used\*

**Leads from a team** – This phrase was used by Patrick Lencioni and describes the ability of a pastor to recognize he needs the gifts and talents of others to administer the pastorate. He cannot do the job alone but must rely on, and collaborate with, his Pastorate Leadership Team and the Pastoral Council. Leading from a team means that the pastor knows or learns how to identify quality leaders who he would place on this Leadership Team. He collaborates with the team and is able to build a trusting relationship with them; he helps the team to function in concert with each other so they can execute a shared vision; he entrusts and empowers the Leadership Team to execute their responsibilities effectively.

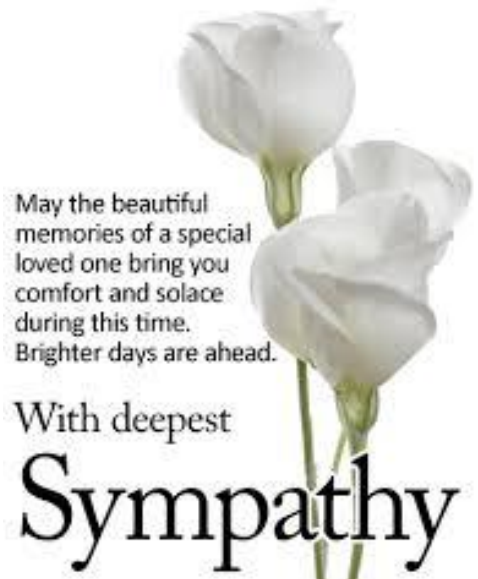

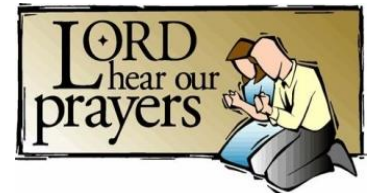
