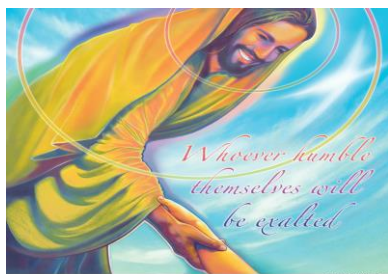

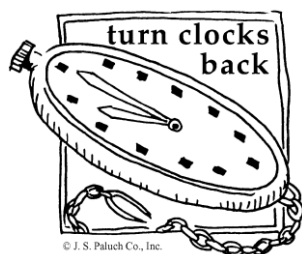
RITE OF PRESENTATION OF CONFIRMATION CANDIDATES:
