Summer Safety

Summer is the time of year when we tend to “take it easy.” It’s a great time to relax, but we should never “relax” safe practices and safety awareness. Below are some guidelines and safe practices for summer activities.

ALWAYS USE SUNSCREEN AS DIRECTED AND KNOW THE SIGNS OF HEAT ILLNESS. THOSE MOST AT RISK INCLUDE

- ⇒ infants and young children, especially when left in hot cars
- ⇒ those 65 and older
- ⇒ people who are ill, have chronic health conditions, those on certain medications
- ⇒ people who are overweight

Boating:

- ⇒ Before setting out check that your equipment is in good working order. Get a free vessel safety check with your local US Coast Guard Auxiliary or US Power Squadron
- ⇒ Before you leave, file a float plan with someone you trust
- ⇒ Life jackets are at the core of safe boating, whether using a motorized or non-motorized vessel.
- ⇒ Carry a distress signaling device on board at all times.

Bicycling:

- ⇒ ALWAYS wear a bike helmet. This includes the “driver” and children in a child safety seat.
- ⇒ Take extra precautions, especially in traffic. Bicyclists often share the road with motor vehicles, so vigilance and awareness are vitally important.

Walking:

- ⇒ Remember to “stop, look and listen” at all corners or driveway and street crossings.
- ⇒ Cell phone distracted walking is a huge problem. Be vigilant.

Fireworks:

- ⇒ Only use fireworks where they are legal
- ⇒ Never allow children to handle fireworks
- ⇒ Never use fireworks while impaired by drugs or alcohol
- ⇒ Never light fireworks indoors and only use them away from people, houses and flammable material
- ⇒ Those near fireworks should wear protective eyewear
- ⇒ Do not try to relight or handle malfunctioning fireworks
- ⇒ Light one device at a time, not in a container, and move a safe distance away after lighting
- ⇒ Keep a bucket of water nearby to fully extinguish fireworks that don’t go off or in case of fire
- ⇒ Soak unused fireworks in water for a few hours before discarding. Do not store them.
- ⇒ Grab a blanket and a patch of lawn, kick back and let the experts handle the show.
- ⇒ The National Safety Council advises everyone to stay away from all consumer fireworks and to only enjoy fireworks at a public display conducted by professionals.

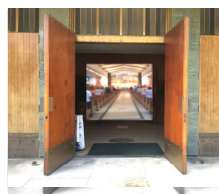


NOVENA

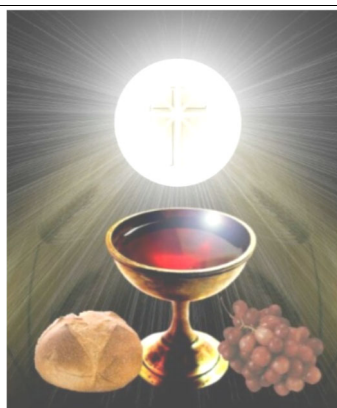

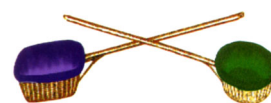
