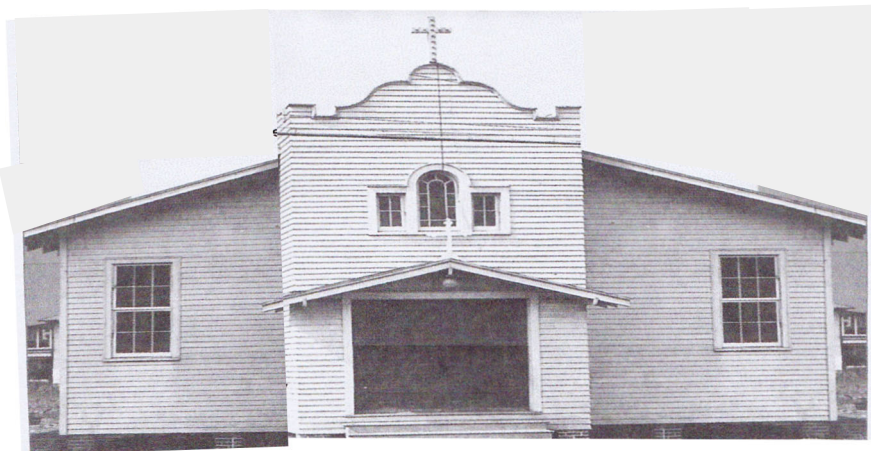

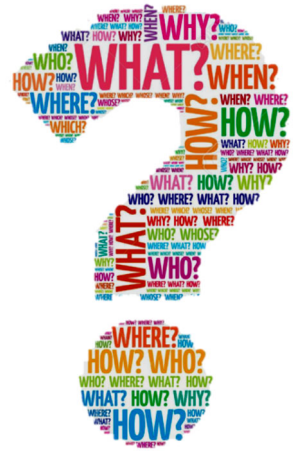


The End of Time
