**TO ALL PARISHIONERS**

Financially St. John the Baptist Catholic Church has relied on a major fundraiser yearly, our Family Day luncheon and raffle. The proceeds from this fundraiser have been necessary to meet our expenses without having to appeal for increases in weekly donations. In 2018 the proceeds from this fundraiser was \$10,432.13 and in 2019 the proceeds from the fundraiser was \$12,074.24.

Due to state restrictions regarding Covid-19 we are unable to have this fundraiser this year, however the church expenses do not change. We have considered ways in which we can generate these necessary funds.

I propose the following solution to our financial crisis.

**Firstly, I would ask those who donate a raffle prize would consider donating the monetary cost on your usual donation. For example: if you have purchased a \$100 gift card please consider donating that amount directly.**

**Secondly, for all the parishioners who generously purchased raffle tickets we would ask you contribute that amount.**

**Thirdly, if you have made donations for the Family Day luncheon or purchased luncheon tickets we would ask you to donate as generously as you can.**

In the future we will have an appreciation luncheon to thank you for your generosity.
