**PILGRIM STATUE OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA:** The Diocese of Bismarck will host the International Centennial Pilgrim Image of Our Lady of Fatima on Monday, Oct. 8 at the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit, beginning at 8 AM and continuing with all-day veneration of the Image. The holy rosary and confession will be ongoing throughout the day; Mass will be celebrated by Bishop David Kagan at 5:30 PM, beginning with a welcoming procession of the statue of Our Lady, followed by Imposition of Scapular and Rosary, coronation of Our Lady, and consecration of families to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Veneration of the Image will continue until 9 PM. During the 100th Anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima in 2017, Pope Francis blessed and conferred the title "International Centennial Pilgrim Image of Our Lady of Fatima" on six statues before sending them on tour to six continents to remind everyone of the Blessed Mother's message for prayer and reparation.
