 Due to state regulations concerned with a person's privacy, the burden is now placed on each individual person admitted into the hospital. The hospital allows the pastor to only see names from a particular parish. If no parish is indicated, pastors will be unaware that you are in the hospital. Visiting the sick is one of the corporal works of mercy, a command by Jesus. By informing others of your hospitalization, you allow others to follow Christ.
