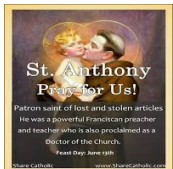

RELIC PILGRIMAGE OF ST. JEAN VIANNEY'S INCORRUPT HEART: The relic tour of the incorrupt heart of St. Jean Vianney will be making a stop at the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit in Bismarck on May 28 and 29. The Shrine of Ars in France, which houses this major relic, has entrusted it to the Knights of Columbus for a nationwide U.S. tour. A rosary will be prayed at 11:30 a.m., with the Litany of Saints to follow. A closing procession will be at noon. Everyone in the diocese is invited to come and venerate this holy relic.
