MINERAL ACRES

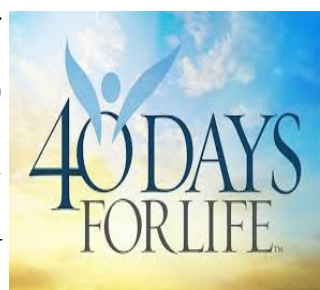

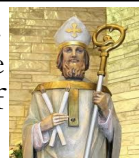
A DAY OF PENANCE

Wednesday, January 22, 2020, is the 47th Anniversary of the US Supreme Court's infamous ruling legalizing abortion during all nine months of pregnancy (Roe v. Wade and Doe v. Bolton). The US bishops have designated this day as a DAY OF PENANCE for the violations to the dignity of the human person, committed through acts of abortion, and of prayer for full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life.
