MINERAL ACRES

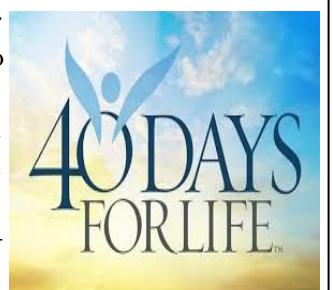

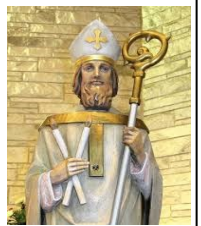
